- ☺ To encourage people to get "out there" on their motorbike(s) and have some fun. "Out there" (it is hoped), will either be off the beaten track or feature an interesting subject, preferably both?
- ☺ An interest in photography is not essential, however it just might add to the enjoyment of the event.
- ☺ In the context of motorcycle riding, the event is not competitive. Badges are awarded for photographing a preset number of locations. Certificates will be awarded for best photo, best set of photos, oldest bike, and smallest bike etc.

Again – as is now traditional - the number of subjects is twenty-four.

There are three categories of Badge - Gold, Silver and Bronze - for photographing 24, 18 and 12 subjects respectively.

A special overall award will be awarded this year for the best additional photo – not connected with the listed locations – that most closely conveys, depicts or somehow encapsulates the spirit of motorcycling in Ireland for 2007, as you interpret it.

All you've got to do between now and November is to visit as many of the listed locations as you choose, in any order you wish, by whatever route pleases you, alone or accompanied as your prejudices dictate. Take a photograph of the nominated subject, be creative if you desire, but include your motorcycle (and pillion passenger if entered) and do seriously consider an entry for that special overall award.

The organizers accept no liability for damage or loss however they might arise.

All participants take part entirely at their own risk and are subject to all the rules and regulations as apply to traffic and/or trespass. Please respect these and any other considerations as may be relevant. Be CAREFUL and DO ENJOY yourself.

It is not necessary to pre enter; you simply submit your photographs; no later than Fri. Nov 30th. 2007 (no exceptions).

Post your photos printed and on disc (if you're digital), please, to Gerry Christie, 26 Monalee, Tralee, Co. Kerry. Photographs by e-mail give us problems. Remember to label each shot fully (they look better in an album). With your photos also please include the above form (fully filled in) and a cheque (crossed and payable to **Lorcan Greene**) for the entry fee of **€ 10** per entrant. **So what are you waiting for, get on with it.**

An E-mail address is important (if you have one) as it minimises administration and helps us to keep you more clearly in the picture.

An award presentation function will be held early in 2008.
